







DEFINITIONS: **Average annual total returns** are the annual compounded returns that would have produced the cumulative total return if fund performance had been constant during the given period. **Average maturity** is the weighted average time period for which the debt securities remain outstanding. Changes in interest rates have greater impact on funds with longer average maturity. **Effective duration** is an estimate of bond price sensitivity to changes in interest rates. The higher the duration, the greater the change (i.e., higher risk) in relation to interest-rate movements. **SEC 30-day yield** is a mandatory yield calculation for bond funds and is essentially a "yield to maturity" for a fund's entire portfolio. The calculation is standardized, so it provides a good measure of comparison for funds. Because bond funds actively trade and prices fluctuate, this yield may not be a good indicator of future results. **Standard deviation** measures performance fluctuation, may not be indicative of future risk and is not a predictor of returns. **Turnover** measures how frequently investments are bought and sold within a fund during a 12 month period. The portfolio turnover rate is as of the fund's fiscal year end and is usually expressed as a percentage of the total value of a fund. **Trailing 12-month yield** is the percentage of income the fund portfolio returned to investors over the past 12 months. It provides recent history of a mutual fund's average dividend and interest payouts.
